


3. Should the combined 'parachute/solidarity payment' be increased from the current percentage of domestic broadcast revenue?







4. Should the Premier League ringfence funding for capital projects such as improvements to stadiums and training grounds for clubs in the English Football League (EFL)?








7. Should domestic cup replays be scrapped, at the stage where Premier League teams enter (i.e. FA Cup Round 3 and EFL Cup Round 2)?






8. Should clubs that have qualified for UEFA competitions play U21 teams throughout the EFL Cup?






9. Should clubs that have qualified for UEFA competitions be prohibited from entering the EFL Cup?








11. Do you feel that football within England and Wales should have an independent regulator?






12. Promotion and relegation should only be based on sporting performance (from the bottom of the pyramid to qualification for Europe).






13. There should be no 'closed leagues' or 'franchise football' across Europe.
