Questions about when and if a decision will be made about the proposed takeover, the viability of 777 as a potential owner and the contingencies in place should the current takeover proposals prove unsuccessful.

In recognition of the fact that in the next few days the Club will be taking part in a second Premier League Commission for breaches of Profit and Sustainability Rules (PSR), we will publish our correspondence to Mr Moshiri, the PL and 777 in full on Wednesday 27 March.
